



PRIVACY POLICY

INTRODUCTION

This privacy policy (“Privacy Policy”) sets forth how POLYCORE THERAPEUTICS, LLC (“POLYCORE,” “we,” “us”) collects, uses, and handles personal information as a visitor (“you”) interacting with us online through POLYCORE’s website (the “Website”).

We urge you to read this Privacy Policy to learn more about the policies and practices POLYCORE has developed to safeguard personal information, to manage our relationships with the third parties who may have access to personal information, and to comply with applicable data protection laws. You will also find information about how to contact us regarding this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy applies only to information collected through the Website and not to information collected offline. Information that is de-identified or anonymized is not considered personal information.

POLYCORE reserves the right to change this Privacy Policy at any time by updating this posting; such changes will apply only to information collected after the date of the change. Therefore, you are responsible for periodically checking this Privacy Policy for changes. Your use of the Website is governed at all times by POLYCORE’s Terms of Use. By using the Website, you consent to the collection and use of your information by POLYCORE in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Personal Information. Generally, you can access and view the Website without disclosing any information that directly identifies you. We do not obtain personal information, which, for the purposes of this Privacy Policy includes any information that can be readily linked back to you as an individual (e.g., name, address, email address, etc.), when you visit our Website unless you choose voluntarily to provide such information. Some areas of our Website may request or require contact or other information, which you may choose to provide if you wish to do so. We do not share your information with any third party without

your consent, except to the limited extent described below under “Use and Disclosure of Collected Personal Information.”

Website Usage. The Website is hosted by a third-party company and thus any information shared with us is necessarily shared with our Website hosting service. However, this third party is contractually obligated not to use any personal information submitted through our Website other than to provide services to us. POLYCORE, or POLYCORE-authorized service providers, may observe your activities, preferences, and transactional data (such as your IP address and browser type) relating to your use of the Website. While we may collect or log this information, we generally do not use this information to identify you or match this information with your other personal information. We may use this collected or logged information to, for example, diagnose technical or security issues, to facilitate your use of the Website, to administer or improve the Website, or to track aggregate traffic patterns throughout the Website.

Recruitment and Job Applications. Using direct submission through the Website or by way of separate email, you may provide us with personal information, such as that contained on a résumé or a curriculum vitae, in connection with a job application or inquiry. We may use this information throughout POLYCORE (worldwide) for the purpose of employment consideration or your inquiry. We may keep your information on file for future consideration.

Non-Public Areas. We may ask you to provide personal information through a registration form before providing you with access to restricted areas of the Website. Regardless of any other provision of this Privacy Policy, we may permanently store any personal information provided by you via such registration form, which allows us to monitor and control access to these restricted portions of the Website.

Children. The Website is not directed toward children, and we do not knowingly solicit or collect personal information online from children under the age of 13 without prior verifiable parental consent. If we learn that a child under the age of 13 has provided personal information on the Website without parental consent, we will take all reasonable measures to delete such information from our databases and to not use such information for any purpose (except where necessary to protect the safety of the child or others as required or allowed by law). PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTED USING COOKIES AND OTHER INTERNET TECHNOLOGIES

Online Data Collection. When you use the Website, third party services we authorize, including Google Analytics and online advertising services, collect data about you and your online activities using cookies and similar technologies. This data may include personal information, for example, your location when you access our Website, the type of device, operating system, and browser you use, and the sites you visit before and after our Website. We do not receive IP address or mobile device identifiers that may be known to the service provider.

We use this information for analytics purposes to create statistical reports about, for example, new and returning visitors to our Website, the pages they access, the websites they visited before and after our Website, general geographic location, the dates and times of their visits, and Website pages accessed. These reports help us understand how our Website is used and performs. We do not use any of this information to directly identify visitors.

We also use this information to deliver marketing messages to relevant users by means of third-party online advertising services that direct ad placement and provide ad response analytics.

USE AND DISCLOSURE OF COLLECTED PERSONAL INFORMATION

Our Operations. parties are contractually limited in the way they may use, and required to maintain the confidentiality of, such personal information.

Business Transaction. If POLYCORE should decide to buy, sell, reorganize, or restructure some part or all of its business, POLYCORE may be required to disclose your voluntarily provided personal information to prospective or actual purchasers or receive personal information from sellers. It is POLYCORE's practice to seek appropriate protection for information disclosed or received in these types of transactions.

As Required by Law and Other Extraordinary Disclosures. POLYCORE may disclose your personal information if it: (a) believes it is reasonably necessary to comply with legal process (such as a court order, subpoena, search warrant, etc.) or other legal requirements of any governmental authority; (b) would be used to assert or defend our legal rights (including disclosures, as relevant, to our accountants, auditors, agents, attorneys, and other advisors); (c) is otherwise reasonably necessary to protect our rights or property; or (d) is reasonably necessary to protect the interests or safety of other users of our Website.

LOCAL PRIVACY RIGHTS

This Privacy Policy applies solely to information collected by the Website.
